






# **Advancing Clinical Practice in Mental Health Clare Allabyrne Course Director Advanced Clinical Practice Mental Health**



Participants included students at various stages of the course from January 2016 to July 2019. The study used a preliminary qualitative evaluation of student experience using semi structured questionnaires, with the results analysed using a thematic analysis framework.

The thematic analysis of the qualitative data has shown a trend and congruence in the positive impact of this role in: difference made to clinical practice and care delivery; feedback from patients and carers; managers/colleagues noticing a difference in care delivery, which includes direct impact on quality of patient care; publication, participation in research; promotion; senior job elsewhere; teaching; setting up physical health clinics.

"There has indeed been an alteration in my practice in that I now utilise higher level clinical assessment skills e.g. physical assessment and diagnosis, which informs treatment and onward referral. In addition, attendance at the leadership module encouraged me to seek promotion and the research module enhanced my critical appraisal of the evidence base and encouraged me to be more assertive in debating it"
